SWIMMER'S Itch sampling will be done close to Messner's near NPP and at the Village Park beach. It is caused by snails and is not a predominate fear at present on our lake. Possible cases on the east end of lake and other isolated areas around the lake. Zebra mussels are on the decline. Quagga mussels data is being collected. The lake manager, Bre Grabill completed the first lake survey last week.

Channel Wall NE side is a current problem area. Mrozinski met with ACE and Senator Booher last week. Before repairs are done an expensive study needs to be completed. Funds are needed from State and Federal to assist. The Tribe has passed a Resolution to support the repairs. Lake levels may rise 8 in. per ACE.

LRBOI Inland Fisheries are not surveying for walleye but Cory Jerome, biologist will survey for sturgeon.

Shaughn Barnett volunteered to help update water quality maps for our Watershed Plan.
